

## Introduction

### **Wireless Remote Control**





❖ Before using the remote control for the first time, remove the transparent insulation tape. See page 10 for battery installation.



1	•	Power	Refer to the "Power On/Off the Projector" section on pages 12-13.
2		Picture Mode	Select the Picture mode from Presentation, Movie, sRGB, Game and User.
3		Computer Source	Press "Computer" to choose Computer connector.
4		Freeze	Freeze To pause the screen image. Press again to resume the screen image.



5	Keystone Correction	Adjust the image to compensate for distortion caused by tilt-ing the projector (vertical ± 40 degrees).
6	Source	Press "Source" to choose RGB, Component, S-Video, Composite and HDTV sources.
7	Menu	Press "Menu" to launch the Onscreen display (OSD), back to the top level of OSD for the OSD main menu operation
8	AV-Mute	Momentarily turn off/on the audio and video.
9	Reset	Change the adjustments and settings to the factory default value.
10	Video Source	Press "Video" to choose Video connector.
11	S-Video Source	Press "S-Video" to choose S- Video connector.
12	Magnify	Zoom the projector display in or out. Use "Magnify", not ◀ or ▶
13	Enter	Confirm your section of items in sub menu operation.
14	Auto Adjust	Automatically synchronize the projector to the input source.
15 *	Four Directional Select Keys	Use ▲ or ▼ or ◀ or ▶ to select items or make adjustments to your selection.
16	Source Lock	Press "Source Lock" to lock specified connection port; press this again to unlock.
17	Volume +/-	Increase/decrease speaker volume.



## **Battery Installation**

1. Press firmly and slide the battery cover off.



- 2. Remove the old Lithium coin cell and install new one (CR2025). Ensure that the side with a "+" is facing up.
- 3. Put the cover back.







Keep the coin cell battery out of reach of children so as not to allow them to swallow the cell battery.

#### **Remote Control Precautions**

- Handle the remote control carefully.
- If the remote control gets wet, wipe it dry immediately.
- Avoid excessive heat and humidity.
- Do not place the battery upside down.



### A CAUTION:

Danger of explosion if battery is incorrectly replaced.

Replace only with the same or equivalent type recommended by the manufacturer. Dispose of used batteries according to your local regulations.



### A CAUTION:
