
Other Operations

Controlling the TV with the Supplied Remote

You can control your TV (SONY only) with the supplied remote.



Controlling TVs with the remote

To control the TV

You can control the TV by using following buttons.

By pressing	You can
TV I/U	Turn the TV on or off.
TV/VIDEO	Switch the TV's input source between the TV and other input sources.
TV VOL +/- while pressing the TV button	Adjust the TV volume.
TV CH +/- while pressing the TV button	Select the TV channel.
Number buttons while pressing the TV button	Select the TV channel.

You can select the TV channels by using the number buttons.


To select the TV channels, press the number buttons, then ENTER.

Note

• Depending on the TV, you may not be able to control your TV or to use some of the buttons above.

Using the THEATRE SYNC Function

THEATRE SYNC allows you to turn on your SONY TV and this system, changes the system mode to "DVD," and then switches the TV's input source you set with one button push.



Preparing for the THEATRE SYNC function

Register the TV's input source connected to this system.

Press and hold TV/VIDEO while entering the code for the TV's input source connected to this system (see the table) using the number buttons.

The TV's input source is selected. Set your TV's input to the input you used to connect the system. For details, see the instructions of your TV.

Operating for the THEATRE SYNC function

Point the remote to the direction of TV and this system, then press THEATRE SYNC once.

If this function does not work, change the transmit time. The transmit time varies depending on the TV.

To change the transmit time

Press and hold TV CH + while entering the code for transmit time (see the table) using the number buttons.


The transmit time from the remote is selected.

By pressing	Number	Transmit time
TV CH +	1	0.5 (Default)
	2	1
	3	1.5
	4	2
	5	2.5
	6	3
	7	3.5
	8	4

Note

- This function is only for SONY TVs. (This function may not work on some SONY TVs.)
- If distance between TV and this system is too far, this function may not work. Install the system near the TV.
- Keep the remote pointed in the direction of the TV and this system while entering the code.

Selecting the connected component

You can use a VCR or other components connected to the VIDEO/SAT jacks on the rear panel. Refer to the operation manual supplied with the components for further information on the operation.

Press FUNCTION repeatedly until "VIDEO" or "SAT" appears in the front panel display.

Each time you press FUNCTION, the mode of the system changes in the following sequence.

When "ATTENUATE" is set to "ATT OFF." DVD \rightarrow TUNER FM \rightarrow TUNER AM \rightarrow VIDEO \rightarrow DVD \rightarrow ...

When "ATTENUATE" is set to "ATT ON." DVD \rightarrow TUNER FM \rightarrow TUNER AM \rightarrow SAT \rightarrow DVD \rightarrow ...

Using a digital satellite receiver or other components with a high audio output level

Connect the satellite receiver to the VIDEO/SAT jacks on the rear panel. You can also connect the components with a high audio output level (including 2V r.m.s components, such as MD, etc.) to the VIDEO/SAT jacks, and perform the following to prevent distortion occurring.

- Press FUNCTION repeatedly until "VIDEO" appears in the front panel display.
- 2 Press AMP MENU.
- 3 Press ↑/↓ repeatedly until "ATTENUATE" appears in the front panel display, then press ENTER or →.
- 4 Press ↑/↓ to select "ATT ON" in the front panel display.


The output level is changed.
When you select "ATT OFF" and press ◆, this operation will be canceled.

The AMP menu turns off.
The function name in the front panel display changes to "SAT."

Tip

• To return to the VIDEO function, select "ATT OFF" at Step 4.

Enjoying the Radio




Presetting radio stations

You can preset 20 FM stations, and 10 AM stations. Before tuning, make sure to turn down the volume to minimum.

- 1 Press FUNCTION repeatedly until the band you want appears in the front panel display.
- **2** Press and hold TUNING + or until the auto scanning starts.


Scanning stops when the system tunes in a station. "TUNED" and "ST" (for stereo program) appear in the front panel display.



- 3 Press TUNER MENU.
- 4 Press ←/↑/↓/→ repeatedly until "MEMORY" appears in the front panel display.
- **5** Press ENTER.

A preset number appears in the front panel display.
