


Using the Remote Control

The following table describes the buttons on the remote control and their functions.


Button Descriptions



Button	Description
1 DVD/VCR (GREEN)	Press to turn on/off the DVD or VCR player.
2 MUTING	Press to mute the sound. "MUTING" will appear on the screen. Press again or press VOL + to restore the sound.
3 WIDE MODE	Press to step through the wide screen modes: Wide Zoom, Normal, Full and Zoom. For details, see "Using Wide Screen Mode" on page 58.
PICTURE MODE	Press repeatedly to step through the available video picture modes: Vivid, Standard and Pro. Also available in the Video menu. For details, see "Selecting Video Options" on page 60.
4 0 - 9	Press 0 - 9 to select a channel, the channel changes after 2 seconds.
ENT	Press to select channel immediately after entering numbers
JUMP	Press to jump back and forth between two channels. The LCD projection TV alternates between the current channel and the last channel that was selected.
5 TOP MENU	When DVD is connected, the title menu list will appear.
6 4/₹/←/⇒	When the menu is displayed, press to move the on-screen cursor.
+	When the menu is displayed, press to select the item.
7 SAT/CABLE FUNCTION	Press to select satellite or cable TV.
8 DVD/VCR FUNCTION	Press to select the DVD/VCR.

13 RESET	Press when in a menu to reset the settings to the factory

14 SLEEP	Press repeatedly until the LCD projection TV displays the
	amount of time (15, 30, 45, 60, or 90 minutes) that you
	want the LCD projection TV to remain on before shutting
	off automatically. To cancel Sleep timer, press SLEEP
	repeatedly until "SLEEP OFF" appears. Pressing POWER
	also cancels the Sleep timer and turns off the power. While
	the Sleep feature is set, press once to view the remaining
	time.
15 SAT/CABLE (GREEN)	Press to turn on/off the satellite or cable TV.

	on page 77.
16 POWER	Press to turn on/off the LCD projection TV. If a video input
(GREEN)	indication (e.g., VIDEO 1, VIDEO 2) appears on the
	screen, press TV/VIDEO or CH +/ – until a channel
	number appears.
17 DISPLAY	Press once to display the current time and channel label (if
	set) and channel number. Press again to turn Display off.

18 TV/VIDEO	Press to cycle through the video equipment connected to your
	LCD projection TV's video inputs: TV, VIDEO 1, VIDEO
	2, VIDEO 3, VIDEO 4, VIDEO 5, VIDEO 6 and VIDEO
	7. If you select Skip as a Video Label in the Setup menu,

19 MENU	Press to display the LCD projection TV on-screen menu.
	Press again to exit from the menu.
20 FAVORITES	Press to display the Favorite Channels list. For details, see

Press to select the TV. The indicator lights up momentarily when pressed to show which equipment the remote control is operating.
Press F1 or F2 to control the connected components (DVD/VCR or DVD/HDD). For details, see "Using Other Equipment with Your LCD Projection TV Remote Control" on page 79.
Press to select the TV or satellite receiver.
Press to change between the VHF/UHF input and the AUX input.
Displays the program guide of your satellite receiver.
Press to scan one-by-one through channels.
To scan rapidly through the channels, press and hold down CH + or CH $-$ (+ up or $-$ down).
Press to scroll an audio option: TruSurround, Simulated, and Off.
Press to scroll through the Multi-channel TV Sound (MTS) options: Stereo, Auto SAP and Mono (see "MTS" on page 63).

Other Information

Programming the Remote Control

The remote control is preset to operate Sony brand video equipment.

Sony Equipment	Programmable Code Number
DVD/VCR	601 (Sony Dream System)
SAT/CABLE	801 (Sony Satellite Receiver)

If you have video equipment other than Sony brand that you want to control with the LCD projection TV's remote control, use the following procedure to program the remote control.

The equipment must have infrared (IR) remote capability in order to be used with the remote control.

From the "Manufacturer's Codes" listed on page 78, select the three-digit code number for the manufacture's code of your equipment. If more than one code number is listed, try entering them one by one until you come to the correct code for your equipment. Use the code number to complete the following procedure.

- Press the DVD/VCR (FUNCTION) and RESET buttons simultaneously, or press the SAT/CABLE (FUNCTION) and RESET buttons simultaneously. The DVD/VCR and SAT/CABLE buttons flash.
- 2 Press the function button you want to program.

To program a cable box or a satellite receiver Press SAT/CABLE (FUNCTION).

To program video equipment

Press DVD/VCR (FUNCTION).

- 3 Enter the three-digit manufacture's code number using the 0 9 buttons.
- Press ENT (enter).
- If no code number is input within 10 seconds, or an invalid or incorrect code number is input, the remote control automatically goes back to the previous setting.
- To check if the code number works, aim the TV's remote control at the equipment and press DVD/VCR and/or SAT/CABLE (POWER) that corresponds with that equipment. If it responds, the programming is completed. If not, try using the other codes listed for that manufacturer.
- In some cases, you may not be able to operate your equipment with the supplied remote control. In such cases, use the equipment's own remote control unit.

Using Other Equipment with Your LCD Projection TV Remote Control

To operate other connected equipment with your LCD projection TV remote control, first turn to page 77 and program the necessary code. For operating video equipment, press TV/VIDEO repeatedly till you see the video input on the screen for your connected equipment. Remote control operation tips are provided below.
