


Inserting Batteries into the Remote control


Insert two size AA batteries (supplied) by matching and on the batteries to the diagram inside the battery compartment of the remote control.

Buttons located at the top of the TV will operate the same as these buttons on the remote control.








- The 5 button and CH + have a tactile dot. Use them as a reference when operating the TV.




