
Remote Control Button Description





• The 5, PLAY and CH+ buttons have a tactile dot. Use them as a reference when operating the TV.

Button	Description
1 DISPLAY	Press once to display the banner with channel/program information you are watching. The banner will time out in about 10 seconds or press again to exit. You can select the banner size based on the amount of information. See Info Banner on page 51.
2 LIGHT	Press to light up the remote control buttons. The FUNCTION button indicator light will light up in red for the device mode the remote control is operating and other buttons will light up in blue (see page 25).
3 FUNCTION Buttons	The FUNCTION button indicator lights up momentarily when pressed to show which external equipment the remote control is operating. These buttons can be programmed to operate external equipment. You must first press one of these FUNCTION buttons to operate the corresponding equipment. See page 25 for "Programming the Remote Control".
4 Equipment Control/ BRAVIA Sync	The buttons listed below can operate video equipment programmed to the DVD , AMP , or STB FUNCTION buttons of the remote control. When the TV FUNCTION button is selected, the buttons can also be used to control the connected equipment with the Control for HDMI function (not available on all Control for HDMI equipment).
	■ PREV: Press to replay the current program from the previous chapter mark (if any) or from the beginning of the live TV cache.
5 SOUND	and the audio will be switched to the audio output of the attached speakers of your BRAVIA Sync audio system. Your BRAVIA Sync audio system must be connected by an HDMI connection to your TV (see page 36 for details). Press to cycle through different sound settings: Dynamic ,
	Standard , Clear Voice . The sound modes can also be accessed in the Sound settings. For details, see Sound settings on page 43.
6 DMe ^x	Press to access features in the optional BRAVIA external module (e.g. DMX-NV1). See your dealer or www.sony.com/bravia for more information. The module may not be available in all regions.



7 FAVORITES Press once to display the Favorites menu. Press again to exit from the **Favorites** menu. See page 28 for detailed information.



8 GUIDE

Press to open the TV Guide On Screen system. Press again to exit the Guide. For instructions on using a specific menu, see "How to Use TV Guide On Screen" on page 34.



9 RETURN

Press to go back to the previous screen or exit from the screen when displaying menu items and settings.

10 HOME

Press to display the **TV Home Menu/XMB**_{TM} to access the TV Home Menu items such as the TV Settings, Photo, Music, TV channels and External Inputs list (see pages 5 and 38).



11 0-9 ENT

Press **0-9** to select a channel; the channel changes after two seconds. Press **ENT** to change channels immediately.

12 ()

Use with **0-9** and **ENT** to select digital channels. For example, to enter 2.1, press (2), (), () and **ENT**.

13 MUTING

Press to mute the sound. Press again or press VOL + to restore the sound.

14 VOL +/-

Press to adjust the volume.

15 DVR/VCR Record

● **REC:** Press to record. Pressing this button alone starts the recording process.

II REC PAUSE: Press to pause recording. **REC STOP:** Press to stop recording.

16 BD/DVD TOP MENU

Buttons

Press to display the top menu of the BD/DVD disc.

17 BD/DVD MENU





Programming Other Equipment



Follow the steps below to program your TV remote control.

- Find the code that corresponds to your equipment from page 26. If more than one code is provided, try programming the first code listed.
- 2 Press and hold DVD, AMP or STB simultaneously with the INPUT button and release. When in the programming mode, the FUNCTION button blinks for approximately 30 seconds until a code is entered.
- 3 Enter the five digit code using **0-9**, while the **FUNCTION** button is lit. If the code is not entered within 30 seconds, you must repeat step 2.
- 4 Press + or ENT to confirm the code. If successfully programmed, the FUNCTION button blinks twice; if not, it blinks five times.



 Any of the FUNCTION buttons can be programmed to operate other equipment regardless of the labeling. For example, DVD can be programmed to operate a Bluray player.

Confirm the Programming

If you can turn your equipment on and off using the green **POWER** button, the programming is complete. If not, try the next code listed.



 In some cases, you may not be able to program your remote control. If this is the case, use your equipment's own remote control.

Auto Backlight

The backlight can be set to light up when a button is pressed.

To set backlight:

Press **LIGHT** and **MUTING** simultaneously until the four **FUNCTION** buttons blink red.

To turn off backlight:

Press **LIGHT** and **MUTING** until the **TV** button blinks red.

Backlight Time Out

The remote control can be set to remain lit longer than the default time setting of approximately five seconds with the **FUNCTION** buttons.

To change backlight time setting:

- 1 Press LIGHT, VOL+, and then CH+ simultaneously until the FUNCTION button blinks red.
- Select the FUNCTION button that corresponds to your preferred time out setting and press

 +).

DVD 5 seconds (default) **STB** 15 seconds

AMP 10 seconds **TV** 20 seconds

Reset the Remote Control

To reset the remote control to the factory default settings, press **SOUND**, **TV POWER**, and then +. The **FUNCTION** buttons blink red simultaneously when successfully reset.
